Jesse M. “Squeaky” Cone, age 87, left this life Saturday, August 1, 2020 at Archbold Hospital in Thomasville, Georgia.

He was born November 21, 1932 in Greenville, Florida to John C. and Myrtle Bishop Cone. He graduated from Madison High School in 1950. He was in the US Army and served his country during the Korean Conflict. He was a rural letter carrier for the US Postal Service and retired after thirty-one years and was a farmer and cattleman. He was also a Charter Member and a Deacon of Landmark Baptist Church in Madison, Florida.
