Mr. John Rogers Winter, age 71, died December 22, 2019 at St. James Health & Rehab near Carrabelle, Florida. A graveside service is scheduled for 11:00 AM on Saturday, January 4, 2020 at Oak Ridge Cemetery in Madison, Florida. John was a retired musician. He was an Eagle scout; he graduated from Ocala High School in 1966 and attended Central Florida Junior College.
