Kenneth Michael Murphy, 62 died on Saturday, January 11, 2014 at the V.A. hospital in Gainesville. He was born January 24, 1951 in Jacksonville, Florida to Marlene Lenzi Murphy and the late Kenneth Raymond Murphy. Coming from Chicago, he resided in Taylor County for the past six years. Mr. Murphy was a self-employed electrician, a member of the Steinhatchee chapter of the American Legion and was of the Catholic faith.
