Marie Lister Evans, age 80, of Pinetta, Florida, passed away Friday, April 8, 2022, in Pinetta, Florida.

She was born in Lanier County Georgia to Lawton and Jeffrie Metts Smith Lister. In 1956, her family moved to Jennings, Florida, where she graduated from high school.

Marie was member of the First Baptist Church of Pinetta, Florida where she had taught Sunday School and Vacation Bible School.

She as the wife of 52 years to Marvin Velton Evans who preceded her in death on December 1, 2009. As an active member of her professional affiliations, she served as Vice-President and President of the Lowndes Georgia Association of Educators, District president of the Georgia Association of Educators. Marie served on numerous school and district committees and councils and taught professional development classes for teachers.
