Ronald Fay Poor, 83, went to be with his Lord on 9 June, 2022. He was an intensely devoted husband and follower of Jesus Christ and a loving father, grandfather and great grandfather. He met the love of his life, Anna Jeannette Stafford, in high school in Gadsden, AL, and they married June 29th, 1959. Ron was ordained as a Baptist Preacher and served as an assistant pastor until enlisting in the U.S. Army where he served for six years both in Vietnam and South Korea. Upon separating from the Army, he became a police officer in Coral Gables, FL, and served his community with honor, grace and distinction for 25 years. He and Jeannette left their home in Homestead, FL following hurricane Andrew in 1992 and after a short time in New Mexico settled down in Greenville, FL. Ron has been a stalwart example of a disciple of Jesus Christ his entire adult life. When not preaching, he served as a Sunday School teacher spending countless hours weekly studying, alongside his wife, preparing for each class to bolster the faith and understanding of those in his class.
