A celebration of life will be at 1pm Tuesday, August 9, 2022, at Beulah Baptist Church in Lee, Florida.

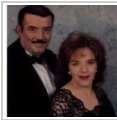

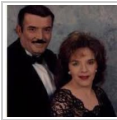
