Stephanie Rochelle Thigpen, age 28, beloved wife and mother, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, June 19, 2016 at Madison County Memorial Hospital following a lengthy battle with brain cancer.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday, June 22, at the First Baptist Church of Madison at 11 a.m. with graveside services following at Cherry Lake First Baptist Church cemetery. Visitation was held on Tuesday, June 21 from 5-8 p.m. at Beggs Funeral Home in Madison.

Stephanie was born on October 30, 1987 to Leonard (deceased) and Donna Yeomans in Valdosta, Ga., and was a Georgia resident until marrying Bryant Thigpen in 2013. Stephanie sang with her family group, The Yeomans Family, from 2001 until leaving the road in 2007.

Bryant and Stephanie were married on August 10, 2013, in Madison. The couple worked together in youth ministry at a local church and were part of a gospel music ministry, LifeSong.
